



• Bonsai trees

There are two ways to introduce **rootgrow™** granules into re-potted trees.

- ✂ Mix the granules thoroughly into the substrate mix.
A 75g sachet of **rootgrow™** will be sufficient for 5 litres of substrate.
- ✂ Sprinkle **rootgrow™** onto the bottom layer of the substrate before placing the tree into the pot.

These methods can also be used for preparing hanging baskets or for plants in pots, outdoor and even indoor plants.

• Containerised plants

1. Dig a planting hole as normal.
2. Sprinkle the **rootgrow™** granules into the bottom of the hole covering **ONLY** the area equal to the base of the plant.
Please refer to the chart below for the amount of granules needed for the container litre size. Adding more **rootgrow™** granules than what is needed will not improve the performance of the tree it will only waste granules and money.
3. Place the plant in the hole directly on top of the **rootgrow™** granules. You should not see any **rootgrow™** granules around the plant once it is placed in the hole.
4. Backfill the hole as normal with compost or soil.
5. Apply fertilisers as a top dressing or mixed into the backfill soil. Do not apply fertilisers directly onto the **rootgrow™** granules.

• Seeds

Grasses or small seeds

- ✂ Mix **rootgrow™** 1:1 with seed and scarify into the soil.

Seed trays

- ✂ Put a layer of **rootgrow™** just below the substrate surface.
When the seed germinates the roots grow through the layer of **rootgrow™**.
